'A bit pongy (in a good way) to begin with but opens up getting woody and raspberry scented, with background stonefruit Viognier smells. Some sweet meaty prosciutto things, too. Attacks plump and raspberryish and forest berry juiciness running down the middle. There's autumn leafiness adding complexity and flinty mineral edge to it. This will appeal to lovers of Torbreck styled shiraz – for less than a third of the price. 91/100'
