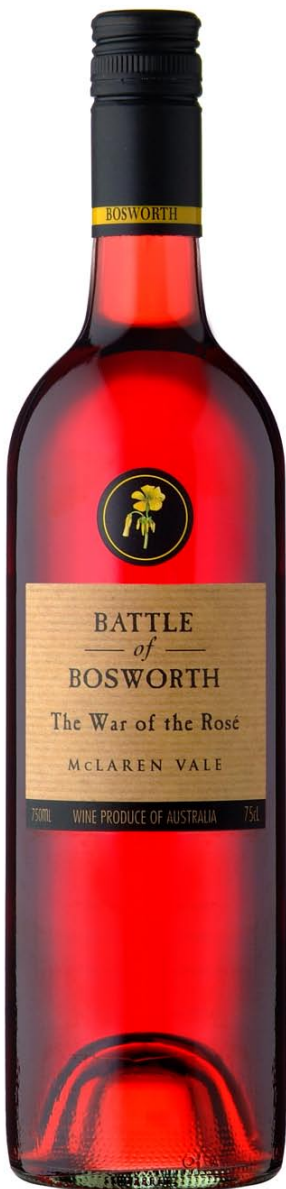

Battle of Bosworth 2008 The War of the Rosé McLaren Vale Dry Cabernet Rosé

'The name sounds much more stoic and serious than the wine, believe me, but this is not giggly sweet pink proposition either.

Consistently among my picks of great South Australian rosé wines, it's a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon rosé that proudly boasts plenty of Cabernet's regal character.

The brightness is instantly appealing, cassis and berry fruit sit up neatly in the glass tempting you in for a sip. The palate can be pushed towards food and also stacks up as a stand alone enjoyment.

Flavours move towards dried red berries as it wraps up with crunchy fresh acid. Handles a decent chill but best enjoyed lightly chilled to get the most from it.'
