## BATTLE OF BOSWORTH McLaren Vale Shiraz 2001

JOCH BOSWORTH GREW THIS ORGANICALLY, LETTING THE SOURSOBS TAKE HOLD EARLY, SO OTHER WEEDS DON'T GET A CHANCE, AND FINALLY THE HUMBLEST OF MEADOW PLANTS MAKES A POSH WINE LABEL.

It's a long and willowy style of wine, more compact and lithe than many Vale reds, and as it airs it plumps up and releases faint hints of peat and perfume.

IT'D BE JUST FINE WITH PIGEON STEWED IN RED WINE AND JUNIPER BERRIES, OR MUTTON SHANKS WITH BIG SAUCE AND PARSNIPS.
