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2002 BATTLE OF BOSWORTH SHIRAZ

Comments: This wine should retail for at least \$25, but I have seen it at \$20. If you do come across it at this crazy price, and you like rich, complex, generous McLaren Vale reds, then snap some up. In fact, if you see it for sale at \$25 - or even more - and you like rich, complex, generous McLaren Vale reds, you might want to consider buying some. Made from certified organic grapes grown on the Bosworth family's Edgehill Vineyards, this shiraz starts quite reticent, blocky, dark and brooding, but if you swirl it around in a big glass (or decant it) it soon loosens up to release seductive, moist, fruitcakelike flavours and a wave of sweet composty warmth. I'm thinking rare eye fillet and mushroom sauce.
