It's not just good, it's a serious, deep, chocka-block wine of fruit flavour and tannin tightness, the depth of it and the balance of it really impressive, even if it is 15% alcohol. Deep, chocolatey plums and cedar with a toasty, glycerol aftertaste. Complete. A sweet, slightly spirity aftertaste. But it's super-powerful at the price. Organically grown. Drink: 2006-2013
