'For many winemakers- and wine drinkers – the attraction of avoiding chemical herbicides, pesticides and fungicides in the vineyard is as much about taste as it is about environmental sensitivity. The idea is that by taking away the chemicals, the grapes (and the wine made from them) can better express the flavours of the soil, climate and season. Witness this delicious certified organic Shiraz. I first came across it in a blind tasting – just one of many glasses of unidentified red wine, but my notes read:"vibrant, soft red fruit, lively, spicy, earthy – tastes like it's from McLaren Vale'
